# Cell Phones For Seniors

Cell Phones For Seniors is part of a national program that provides refurbished cell phones free to people who do not have cell phones. The free phones cannot be used to make routine calls, but they are capable of connecting to 9-1-1 emergency centers.

Many Senior Citizens don't have cell phones, so free cell phones offer them a new, portable method of calling for help.

All St. Tammany Senior Citizens qualify for a free phone if they do not have a cell phone, or if a couple is sharing a single cell phone. Those couples that have no cell phone may be given two phones, based on availability.

Those who qualify will be given a phone, two batteries, and a cell phone charger.

Cell Phones For Seniors is part of the SALT Senior Security program.

Requests for free emergency cell phones will be fulfilled when phones are available.

The Cell Phones For Seniors program is possible through the 911 Cell Phone Bank, a partner of the National Sheriffs' Association.

In cooperation with the 911 Cell Phone Bank, the SALT Council collects old cell phones for recycling. All cell phones, even old bulky "bag" phones, are suitable for this purpose, as are non-working phones that may be useful for parts to refurbish other phones.

Although there is no limit on the number of phones available to the SALT Council, the number of phones provided to the SALT Council is limited by the number of acceptable phones submitted for recycling. It is important for the SALT Council collect as many cell phones as possible to submit to the national foundation.

Individual or large group phone donations are welcome. Call, fax, or e-mail the SALT Council for collection box locations, or to arrange pickup of phones donated for recycling.
